


2023 Wisconsin Milking Shorthorn Breeders Association Memorial Scholarship



This is a \$1000 scholarship awarded to any student who is a National Junior Milking Shorthorn member *and* is a Wisconsin Milking Shorthorn Breeders Association (WMSBA) member (or their family unit holds a WMSBA membership). The student must be either a high school senior planning to attend or current student at an accredited college or vocational school, and be 21 years of age or younger, as of January 1st of the year applying. This scholarship will give special preference, but not be limited, to students pursuing agricultural studies. Students can apply every year they qualify until they are selected, age out or graduate.
